DONAUBRÄU

With a view of the Danube Park and specially brewed Tower Beer, visitors enjoy cozy hours here and can further soak up the atmosphere of the Danube Tower in the light and airy hall, similar to a pavilion.

A special visual highlight are the unique artworks by Nicola Verlato, an Italian-American artist of surrealism. His works can be found backlit on the ceiling of the pavilion, giving visitors the feeling of being "top of Vienna" even though they are in the lower part of the Danube Tower.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Information and regulatory requirements at the Danube Tower

Please note that these regulations are provisions from the notice on the operating facility permit and therefore unfortunately no exceptions can be made. The regulations serve to protect all visitors, especially in case of fire or disaster.



Dog owners

Dogs are not permitted on the Danube Tower in accordance by the authorities. Please leave your dog in suitable care on the ground. Guide dogs and assistance dogs are permitted.

Wheelchair users

In the express-lifts, only one person in a wheelchair per car may be transported to exit point 1 (viewing platform). Each wheelchair user must be accompanied by a person who can transport the wheelchair user if necessary. A maximum of 3 wheelchair users may be present in the tower's viewing platform at the same time. The stairs to the restaurant areas and the stairs to the indoor terrace cannot be used with wheelchairs.

Therefore, it is unfortunately not possible to visit these areas with a wheelchair. If you are able to walk short distances, our staff will be happy to show you the parking space provided for wheelchairs in the entrance area. The newly designed ground-floor areas - the Donaubräu and the shop are of course barrier-free.

Strollers



Strollers are not allowed in the express lifts; therefore, they cannot be taken to the viewing platform, the Turm Café or the Turm Restaurant. Our staff at the ticket office will be happy to show you a place where you can leave your stroller.
